The Shelter Association of Washtenaw County serves any individual in need at the level which they are ready and willing to accept.

Most of the public attention is focused on the residential portion of our programming, our Night Shelter Program. This program is for individuals who are ready and willing to make a commitment to find or increase their income and find sustainable housing and are drug and

alcohol free. Approximately 240 individuals, or 20% of the individuals served at the Robert J. Delonis Center, participate in this program.

For individuals who are not yet ready to make that commitment to change, the Shelter Association offers a broad range of services designed to meet their needs and encourage them to take the necessary steps to regain income and housing. Available services include basic needs such as showers, clothes and laundry, but additional services

The effect of Pfizer closing its Ann Arbor facility will ripple throughout the entire community; it will affect all aspects of life from the housing market to the farmers' market; one area that will be especially hard hit is the many non-profits that received significant support from the company and its employees.

The Shelter Association has been the recipient of Pfizer's generosity through direct corporate gifts, donations from employees and their matching contribution by Pfizer, and community grants. Pfizer has been the second largest funder of the Shelter Association's health and hygiene programs, donating over \$20,000 per year to our programs. The loss of this revenue will severely hamper the Shelter Association's ability to provide services ranging from medical appointments to access to showers.

The Shelter Association's health clinic provided services to over 1,100 individuals through 2,300 clinic visits in the most recent fiscal year. As a community, providing access to health care for those who are unable to afford private insurance is not only the right thing to do, it is the smart thing to do. In a survey of health clinic clients approximately 50% of respondents stated that if they did not have access to our facility they would have accessed health care at an emergency room, while another 20% responded that they would not have accessed health care at all.

Pfizer's support also allowed us to provide access to hygiene services such as showers, laundry and personal hygiene products through the Shelter Association's service center. For many of our clients access to these facilities is more than a nicety – it helps keep chronic skin conditions under control, prevents infection of minor cuts and abrasions, helps prevent the spread of contagious illnesses, and of course improves their chances of finding and/or maintaining employment.



The Shelter Association is pleased to introduce our new Volunteer Coordinator, Laura Rayburn. Laura brings a contagious enthusiasm for helping people in the community and loves working with all of the Shelter Association's dedicated volunteers. She is also working diligently to build new ties to the faith based communities in Ann Arbor and the surrounding area.

We were very fortunate to have Jen House on staff as Volunteer Coordinator until last month. Under Jen's guidance, the volunteer program grew from infancy into the well-established and well-respected program that it is today. Last year alone, volunteers contributed over 17,000 hours, providing essential support to clients and staff throughout the night and day. Without the help of our many volunteers, services available at the Delonis Center would be greatly reduced.

Volunteer shifts are set up to accommodate most schedules and lifestyles and offer a variety of ways to help out. Orientation sessions are held monthly for all people who are interested in volunteering at the shelter. such as health care, benefit assistance and support groups are also available if they choose to access such services.

When an individual is ready to move forward they can simply expand upon the relationships they have already built. In many cases the staff has been working with that individual over a period of months or even years. Whether that means entering detox, taking psychiatric

medication or leaving an abusive relationship, the Shelter Association will be there to provide the support they need to be successful.

The Shelter Association does more than simply provide basic necessities that keep our clients alive; we connect them to many services that help them reach the point where they are ready to move forward.
